What qualifications are required to take part in the Challenge?	No specific qualification is required to take part in the Challenge. Participation is open to anyone who is able to provide a proposal that complies with the requirements and with the Rules' terms and conditions. Enel employees are excluded from the Challenge.
What are the main elements that I have to take into account to design the interior of the cabinet?	The important information to consider to take part in the Challenge, regarding the interior of the street cabinet, is the dimensions of the internal devices and the regulatory standards. This information is given in the "Technical requirements of the street cabinet" paragraph.
